In 2018, a group of experts identified by the **CNBBSV of the Presidency of Council of Ministers** prepared a document on the potential role of microbiomes in the:

- agro-food systems and
- human health.

More recently, they draw up the “Action Plan for the industrial implementation of the Italian microbiome initiative for improved human health and agro-food production” in close cooperation with:

- the national Technology Clusters ALISEI and CLAN and
- 16 among the most prominent Italian industries from the health and agro-food system domains.

Together with them, S.I.I.T. today, discussed the latter with all major European and international organizations working in the sector.
